rules: The competition rules of the DTU are valid, with the following

modification:

for individual, pair, synchron:

1. 2 rounds for all competitors: semi-final and final.

2. Achieved points from the semi-final will count for the final.

3. A change of the category (age-group/graduation) is not permitted.





- 4. The compulsory Poomsae for each category are defined in this outline.
- 5. Two different Poomsae has to be shown. Competitors with the 9th and 8th Kup are allowed to repeat Taeguk 1.
- 6. For pair and synchrony, the competitor with the lowest graduation defines the Poomsae.
- 7. For pair and synchron, same and mixed gender teams are allowed.

for hanbon-kyorugi (= Einschrittkampf):

- 1. 1 round for all competitors: final.
- 2. It will be shown 4 attacks only with the fist.
- 3. Thrown actions are not permitted.
- 4. The defence should consist of minimum 3 movements.
- 5. It's not allowed to hit the attacker after the defence movement.
- 6. Only the defender will be scored.
- 7. The overall impression of techniques will be scored.

for family:

- 1. 2 competitors can start as a family.
- 2. 1 round for all competitors: final.
- 3. The Poomsae can be chosen freely.
